FOR THE 2027 - 2028 SCHOOL YEAR

STEP 1: START YOUR APPLICATION ONLINE

- 1 Visit staugustinehigh.com/admissions and select the **APPLY NOW** button.**
 - New Families: Create an account → verify email → set password
 - Returning Families: Log in with existing account
- 2 Online Admissions Application**

Complete the online application filling in all the required fields.
- 3 Recommendation Forms and Academic Records Request**

Email addresses needed for the following:

 - Email address of an English or Math Teacher
 - Email address of an Administrator (Principal, Assistant/Vice Principal, or Counselor)
 - Email address of the Registrar (*transcripts, standardized tests scores and if applicable, accommodation learning plan*)

(St. A's communicates directly with all middle schools to request these documents and academic records.)
- 4 Submit Additional Information**
 - Financial Aid Survey
 - Accommodation Learning Plan (*If Applicable*)
CAP, IEP, ISP, or 504 plan documentation needed
 - Public School Verification Form
 - Previous Award Verification Form
- 5 Check Application Status**
 - Log in to your parent portal to receive updates on recommendation forms and academic records submissions

STEP 2: STUDENT AND PARENT INTERVIEW

Once your online application and all required documents—including transcripts and recommendations—have been received, our Admissions Director will contact you by email to schedule an on-campus student and parent interview.
